Falkirk Otter ASC invites you to their Annual Age Group Swim Meet to be held at Grangemouth Sports Complex, Abbots Road, Grangemouth, FK3 8JB, under SASA Licence no: WD/L2/021/0323.

The meet will target 11 - 18 years age groups with 100m events for all strokes plus 200m IM & 400m Freestyle events.

MEET INFORMATION

VENUE Grangemouth Swimming Pool, Abbots Road, Grangemouth, FK3 8JB

POOL 25m x 6 lanes, anti-wave lane ropes

EVENTS 100m all strokes, 200m IM & 400m Free

Session 2 has an 8 x 50m mixed freestyle relay consisting of 4 girls & 4 boys (1 girl and 1 boy from each age group in that order and ascending age)

Swimmers can swim up an age group but can only be entered into one relay. All events are heat declared winners. It may be necessary to limit the

number of heats in certain events.

AGE GROUPS 11-12 years, 13-14 years, 15-16 years, 17-18 years.

Age on day of the meet.

SESSIONS Session 1: warm-ups: 9.00am session starts 10.00am

Session 2: warm-ups: 1.30pm session starts 2.30pm

OFFICIALS Can each club supply at least 2 swimming technical official for each Session

of which we request 1 is a Judge, to ensure accreditation. A SignupGenius

form for STO's will be provided after the entry closing date.

Medals will be awarded to 1st to 3rd places for all events. **AWARDS**

Medal winners will be announced throughout the sessions and be available for collection at the medal desk.

There will be awards for the top boy and girl in each age Group.

The 'Otter Trophy' for the TOP CLUB will be presented to the club with the most combined points at the end of the 2 meets over the weekend (Falkirk Otter Development Meet & Falkirk Otter Age Group Meet). Trophy to be returned after 1 year. Small trophy to be retained.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Meet to be held under SASA rules. Enclosed is a health and safety form to be completed (mandatory).
- 2. All Swimmers must have a S.A.S.A. or A.S.A. registration number.
- 3. Start sheets will be available to clubs prior to the start of each session.
- 4. Electronic Timing will be in operation. In the event of electronic failure, back-up manual timing will be used.
- 5. Withdrawals must be notified to the recorders no later than 40 minutes prior to the start of each session.
- 6. Once start sheets have been prepared no alterations shall be made.
- 7. It is the swimmer's responsibility to check with the marshalls in the allocated area. Swimmers should report to the marshalls FIVE heats in advance of their race.
- 8. Swimmers, coaches and team managers must ensure that all their swimmers can safely dive into the deep water as prescribed by current legislation.
- 9. There will be a maximum of 2 no reserve swimmers for each event. Would clubs also note that under no circumstances should any swimmer other than the one named on the start sheet go to the marshalling area.
- 10. No photographic or video equipment will be allowed in any area under the jurisdiction of the meet organizers without prior approval of the meet convenor. Application must be made on the approved SASA form.
- 11. Swimmers must act on the instructions given by the meet officials and behave in a reasonable manner at all times.
- 12. It is the responsibility of each club to ensure that their swimmers are aware of meet rules.
- 13. The Meet Management reserves the right to alter the programme and warm-up times if necessary. Anything not covered above or printed in the event programme will be at the convenor's discretion.
- 14. The convenor reserves the right to restrict entries in order to facilitate the smooth running of the meet. Entries will be accepted on time basis. Clubs should ensure entry times are accurate. Rejected entries will be refunded in full.

MISCELLANEOUS

- There will be a Raffle stall.
- Swimmers and Coaches must not take glassware into the showers or onto poolside otherwise they will be liable for expulsion from the meet.
- Falkirk Otter ASC nor Grangemouth Sports Complex can be held responsible for loss or damage to swimmer's, team staff or spectator's property. Swimmers are strongly advised to secure property in the lockers provided in changing rooms and not to leave belongings lying around unattended.
- Swimmers out with the pool side must wear dry clothing and footwear at all times.
- Outdoor footwear must not be worn at poolside.

HEALTH AND SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENT

Controlling the Use of Photographic Equipment

Scottish Amateur Swimming Association has decided that control of photographic equipment is required at all meets.

In view of this, the meet will run under the following guidelines:

- No photographic equipment (eg, Camera, Camcorder, camera phones, Ipads or similar etc) is to be allowed on poolside, spectator gallery or any other area under the jurisdiction of the meet organisers without prior approval of the meet director.
- Application to use photographic equipment must be made on the approved SASA form at the entrance desk.
- Application can be made on the day to the meet convenor or to the meet convenors appointed official. Applicant must provide proof of identity when applying and carry such proof when intending to use their photographic equipment.
- Also a reminder that photos and video clips can only be uploaded to secure club websites.
