<b>Age Groups and Events</b>	8-9 years: 50m Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly 10-11 years: 100m Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly and Individual Medley 12-13 years: 100m Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly and Individual Medley 14&over: 100m Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly and Individual Medley All events are HDW (Heat Declared Winners) <b>Age on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2024.</b>
<b>Prizes</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> will be presented to each swimmer in each event Medals can be collected from the Medals Table during the session. Too Fast Awards (for swimmers that swim faster than the ‘slower than’ times specified on page 3 of this document) will also be presented.
<b>Poolside Pass</b>	Poolside Passes entitle the holder to entry to the poolside, early morning sausage or bacon roll, tea/coffee throughout the day, lunch and start sheet. They can be purchased at £10.00 each per coach/team manager/chaperone per weekend. Please note that some of the offering is to be confirmed and if we are unable to provide some of it, clubs will be entitled to a refund which will be processed as soon as possible after the meet.
<b>Spectating</b>	Spectating be available at the meet with a £3.00 all-day charge for all spectators.
<b>Car Parking</b>	At the pool and at an overflow parking area adjacent to Horizon Hotel (5 min walk).
<b>Accommodation</b>	A list of hotels can be obtained from Ayr Tourist Office on 01292 678100. Craig Tara Caravan Park is also a source of accommodation.
<b>Local Amenities</b>	The Citadel Leisure Centre is a short walk from Ayr Town Centre where all local amenities are available. The nearest local shop is Seafield Stores, 43-45 Blackburn Dr, Ayr KA7 2XW.
<b>Next SAST Meet</b>	<b>The next SAST meet is expected to be our SAST Mini Meet in January 2024. More information will be available in due course.</b>

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1	The pool is 25m long x 6 lanes, with anti-turbulence lane ropes and swim-down facility.
2	Swiss Timing electronic timing.
3	All swimmers of Scottish clubs must have a current SASA membership number. All swimmers of non-Scottish clubs must be registered with their governing body.
4	No photographic or video equipment shall be allowed in any area under the jurisdiction of the Meet Organisers without prior approval of the Meet Manager. Applications must be made on the SASA approved form available at the Meet Office (or Spectators Desk in the gallery / Medal Table on poolside).
5	Swimmers, coaches, and team managers must ensure that all their swimmers can safely dive into deep or shallow water as prescribed by current/planned legislation. No diving is allowed at the shallow end of the pool.
6	A one-way system around the pool will be in operation.
7	Warm-ups will be split to accommodate the numbers and age range of competitors and as per schedule of events. It is the coaches' responsibility to supervise their swimmers during warm-ups.
8	Over the top starts will be used during the Meet at the discretion of Meet Manager/Referee.
9	Entries to events will be restricted and will be accepted based on entry times. Any entry not accepted will be refunded. If there are reserve swims and a reserve swimmer attends and does not get a swim, a full refund will be issued. A list of scratched entries will be sent to the Contact stated on the Meet Entry form. It is the responsibility of the person receiving confirmation of the entries to check the accuracy of the accepted swims and to inform all relevant swimmers of their accepted entries.
10	We will accept withdrawals (in writing via email to Elaine Walker and Karen Thomson <a href="mailto:sast.bubble@gmail.com">sast.bubble@gmail.com</a> ) up to Wednesday 2 <sup>nd</sup> October at 8pm, to allow us to inform any reserves (if there are any) in advance of the meet.
11	Withdrawal slips will be available in Coaches' packs. Withdrawals will be allowed <u>up to 60 mins before the start of each session</u> . Start sheets will be available for Coaches and Team Managers. Marshalling is compulsory. Swimmers will be called for in whole events at least one event prior to their swim and marshalled into heats in the designated marshalling area. Swimmers will then be sent in heat order to the starting blocks.
12	SAST reserve the right to fill lanes with their swimmers where an event is under subscribed. SAST reserve the right to scratch events when there are insufficient entries.
13	Only poolside pass holders, swimmers, technical officials and meet personnel shall be allowed on to the poolside.
14	To ensure accreditation for each session we would appreciate support from participating Clubs by nominating Technical Officials qualified to Judge level.
15	It is the coaches' responsibility to supervise their swimmers using the swim down pool – if this facility is abused it may have to be withdrawn.
16	Start Lists and Results will be available on the Meet Mobile app.
