Entries, Withdrawals and Start Lists

- The meet will be run using Hytek meet Manager, requested for entry files should be submitted by email to programming@stirlingswimming.co.uk.
- 25m conversions are accepted
- Entries will be accepted on a time basis. It is the responsibility of Entry Secretaries to ensure all entry times and dates of birth are correct
- Where an event is over-subscribed, entries may be scratched, to ensure the smooth and timely running of the meet. Scratches will be made proportionally across all age/gender groups. NT times will not be accepted.
- Should the event be oversubscribed we reserve the right to forgo the relay events to give more time for individual swims.
- Participating clubs will be provided with a list of confirmed swims and scratches and a copy of the Programme within 2 weeks of the closing date. Any scratches will be fully refunded. Once draft programme issued no further refunds will be given.
- Withdrawals made after issue of the programme will be charged in full.
- Please email any withdrawals to the programming@stirlingswimming.co.uk as soon as possible and no later than 5:00pm Wednesday 17th September 2026.
- Start lists will be issued to all clubs, prior to the start of a session, once all the withdrawals have been processed.
- The use of photographic or video equipment is permitted within the guidelines issued by Scottish Swimming (see Meet Rules).
- Flash photography is not permitted due to the risk of false starts

Officials

Each competing club are requested to supply at least 2 Technical Officials (with one being J1 or above) to enable the meet to run smoothly and gain accreditation. Meet Rules

- The meet will be held under SASA rules, enclosed is a Health & Safety Declaration Form to be completed (Mandatory). Please return this with your Entry Summary Form prior to the meet date.
- Level 3 Licence has been requested for this meet. Licence No. WD/L3/0926/048
- All swimmers must have a current SASA registration number or be registered with the appropriate governing body.
- No swimmer under the age of 8 years is permitted at this meet.
- Current SASA swimsuit regulations should be adhered to at this meet.
- Electronic timing will be in operation. In the event of the electronic timing failing, manual timing will be used hence the need to have sufficient STO's to ensure this is available.
- Only Swimmers, Coaches, Team Managers and Meet Officials will be admitted poolside.
- Swimmers must act on the instruction given by the Meet Officials and always behave in a reasonable manner. Outdoor footwear must not be worn on poolside and swimmers out with the poolside must always wear dry clothing and footwear.
- Swimmers and coaches must not take glassware into the changing village or onto poolside.
- Stirling Swimming Club cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to property during the meet.
- It is the responsibility of the swimmers to report to the marshalling area a minimum of four heats in advance.
- Coaches must ensure that all swimmers can safely dive into the deep water as prescribed by current legislation. There will be NO diving at the shallow end of the pool. Over the top starts to be used to ensure the smooth running of the meet. Requests to start in the pool will be at the discretion of the referee.
- The meet organisers are aware of the wide range of devices including mobile telephones which have photographic and filming capabilities. This enables the capture of both static and moving images. It should be acknowledged that most images taken within Scottish Swimming licensed meets are appropriate and taken in good faith. However, images of children and adults can be misused, and sharing images widely without consent may betray a confidence or identity of a child or adult, which could present a risk of harm to that individual if common sense procedures are not followed.

Spectators who wish to take images are requested to focus on their own family member as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other participants in images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends or through social media platforms.

The meet organisers are committed to ensuring that all children who participate in this meet are able to take part in an enjoyable, safe environment and be safeguarded from harm. If there are any child safeguarding concerns at the event, please contact the Meet Organiser immediately to disclose your concerns.
- The Scottish Swimming Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy was implemented on 1st January 2024. The policy and FAQs can be found [HERE](#). Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff.

At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.
- The primary safeguarding point of contact for the event in relation to wellbeing & protection matters or accidents is the Meet Organiser. The secondary point of contact is the Scottish Swimming Safeguarding Manager.
- It is the responsibility of each club to ensure that their swimmers are aware of the Meet Rules.
- The Meet Management reserves the right to alter the programme and warm up times if necessary. Anything not covered above or printed in the event programme will be at the Gala Convenor's discretion.
